RoHS STATEMENT



The Directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances(RoHS II).replacing Directive 2002/95/EC(RoHS I). targets Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) in order to avoid adverse impacts on human health and the environment.

Roles and obligations have been identified by Greenconn to the best of its knowledge .RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU was amended by the Directive(EU)2015/863, which was published in June 2015. Four additional substances(phthalates) were added to Annex II of the original RoHS Directive . The provisions regarding the restriction of the newly added substances in ' Electrical and Electronic Equipment 'apply from22.07.2019.Annex II now contains the following list of restricted substances and their tolerated maximum concentration values (MCV) by weight (w/w) in homogeneous materials (specific exemptions may apply or products be out of scope):
